Participation in the Affiliate Program immerses affiliates in the inquiry and exploration of new tools and methods that promise increased productivity, more predictable schedules, fewer defects, and increased savings. In short, the time invested in the program will return dividends for many years to come.

Sponsoring organizations assign key, qualified members of their technical staffs to work with a team of SEI staff members to identify, develop, and demonstrate improved practices for specific technology domains for a term of collaboration.

As team members on SEI projects, affiliates study groundbreaking technologies and processes that help software development organizations make the most of their resources. They become part of the institute's ongoing effort to define superior software engineering practices.

The affiliate program was originally designed for affiliates to be on-site at the SEI. While the benefits of being on-site are tremendous, we realize that the full residency requirement is not always feasible. Therefore, we are willing to offer other arrangements in cases where potential affiliates offer special skills or exceptional transition opportunities.

Affiliates may have residency from six months to four years, but their work at the SEI will have a lasting effect on the future of the software engineering.

There is no charge to participate in the affiliate program. During the affiliate term, an affiliate's salary and living expenses are paid by his/her sponsoring organization.
